Palmer Farm

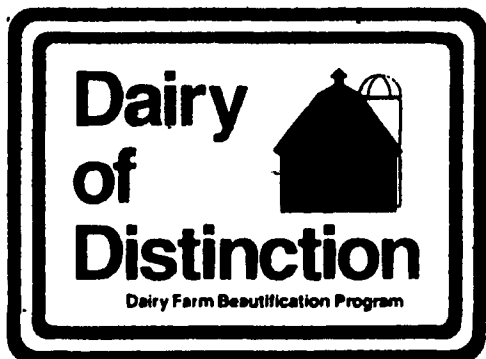
Lonnie and Debra and Brad and Linette Palmer keep the farming done on this Fulton County Dairy of Distinction. With 115 milk cows (Holsteins) and 80 young stock, the Palmers maintain a 20,000 lb. rolling herd average. They milk in a station barn with housing in a free stall set up. Corn, hay, oats and barley grains are raised on the 450 acres they till. Brad represents the fifth generation of the family on the farm that is located south of Needmore of Rt. 522.

Wagner Farm

This Forest County Dairy of Distinction is owned by Gaylord and Martha Wagner and their children Tracy, Neil, and Jay. They have 130 Registered Holsteins, and their 60 cows average 18,000 lbs. of milk. The facilities include a computerized feeding system and a free stall barn. Farming has been a tradition dating back to when the family moved from Germany in the 1830's. They are located near Tionesta.
