Soybean Yield Contest Set

LANDISVILLE (Lancaster Co.) — The 1993 Pennsylvania Soybean Yield Contest is open for producers who farm in Pennsylvania and who produce five acres or more of soybeans within Pennsylvania's boundaries.

The purpose of the contest. sponsored by the Pennsylvania Soybean Promotion Board, is to

demonstrate the practices necessary to produce maximum economic yields and to encourage the production of high-quality sovbeans.

According to the board, participants will be restricted to nonirrigated soybeans only, but will not be restricted as to variety, fertilization, spacing, or other cultural

August 15, and intent must be submitted to the Pennsylvania Soybean Promotion Board, ATTN: John Yocum, P.O. Box 308, Landsiville, PA 17538.

According to the board, three acres in one block (for example, 209 feet X 627 feet equals 3 acres) from a field of at least five acres

within the physical boundaries of the state must be selected by the grower. A designated representative (other than the grower) must measure the test area, be present when the test area is harvested, supervise weighing on stateinspected scales or an approved weigh wagon, and sign the report.

Only one entry per farm will be accepted. There is no charge for participating in the contest. A designated representative shall arrange for official sampling and moisture determination of the harvested soybeans as well as obtain a sample for grading. Moisture content will be obtained on a state-approved moisture meter from the sample drawn. Acre yields will be calculated on the basis of 13 percent moisture. All foreign material in excess of 1 percent will be deducted from the gross weight.

Awards will include a trophy and designated State Yield Champion for the grower who produced the greatest yield per acre. Also, second and third place winners will also be recognized with trophies. Each contestant who produces in excess of 60 bushels per acre from a plot officially entered into the contest will receive an engraved plaque designating membership in the 60-Bushel
