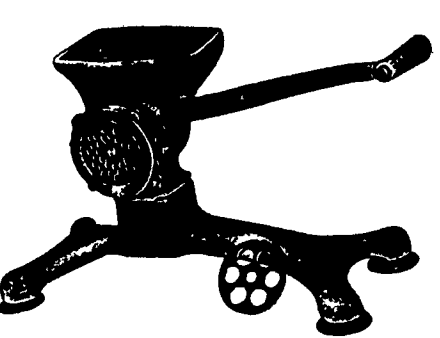

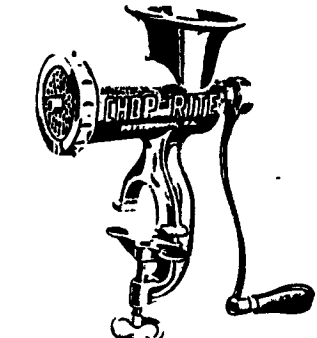

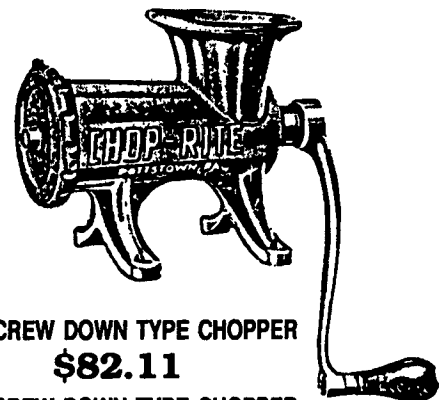


#1 CLAMPLESS TYPE CHOPPER

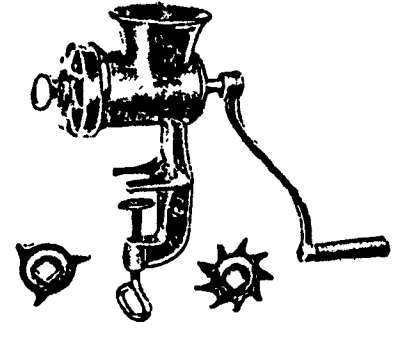
