SOYBEAN PRICES LOWER, WEDNESDAY, WITH FAVORABLE GROWING CONDITIONS A MAJOR FACTOR. WHEAT 1 TO 2 CENTS LOWER EXCEPT MINNEAPOLIS SPRING WHEAT UP 40 CENTS. CORN UNCHANGED TO 2 CENTS LOWER. SORGHUM 2 TO 3 CENTS LOWER. SOY-BEANS 7 TO 10 CENTS LOWER. WHEAT PRICES FELL SLIGHTLY DUE PARTIALLY TO HARVEST PRESSURE. HARD RED WINTER WHEAT HARVEST LATE BUT TRYING TO FINISH UP AND SPRING WHEAT HARVEST ALREADY UNDERWAY. COMBINES RUN FROM NORTHERN KANSAS TO SOUTH DAKOTA AND ALONG THE SAME LINE INTO THE EASTERN CORNBELT. MINNEAPOLIS SPRING WHEAT TURNED SHARPLY HIGHER IN REACTION TO TUESDAY'S SUBSTANTIAL DECLINES. BARGE TRAFFIC REMAINS TIED UP BUT INCREASED RAILCARS MOVING OUT AS MORE LINES EMERGING FROM RECENT DEEP WATERS. TWO OR THREE IMPORTANT RAILYARDS IN KANSAS CITY ROUTING MORE TRAFFIC THIS WEEK. VERY GOOD EXPORT BUSINESS FOR WHEAT THIS WEEK LIMITED PRICE LOSSES. SLIGHT DECLINES IN CORN PRICES DUE TO CONTINUED LACK OF NEW EXPORT DEMAND. GOOD GROWING WEATHER IN CORN BELT THROUGH EARLY WEEK BUT SHIFT TO COOLER TEMP-ERATURES, UNDERPINNED PRICES. SOYBEAN PRICES FELL MODERATELY AFTER THE PAST COUPLE DAYS OF HIGHER TRENDS. FORECASTS FOR MUCH NEEDED RAIN IN SOUTHEASTERN U.S. AND PROFIT TAKING ON THE BOARD, WEIGHED ON BEAN PRICES. VERY LITTLE EXPORT INTEREST FOR SOYBEANS ALSO A NEGATIVE

**EXPORT NEWS:** JAPAN BOUGHT 228,064 TONNES OF WHEAT FOR OCTOBER SHIPMENT. LEBANON BOUGHT 100,000 METRIC TONS HARD RED WINTER WHEAT, UNDER EEP, FOR 93/94 MARKETING YEAR. USDA ACCEPTED A BID TO SELL 55,000 TONNES SOFT RED WINTER WHEAT TO FORMER USSR UNDER EEP, FOR AUGUST/SEPTEMBER SHIPMENT. USDA ACCEPTED A BID TO SELL 23,000 TONNES NORTHERN/DARK NORTHERN SPRING WHEAT AND 12,000 TONNES WESTERN WHITE WHEAT TO THE PHILIPPINES, UNDER EEP, FOR SEPTEMBER. USDA ACCEPTED A BID TO SELL 2,200 TONNES HARD RED WINTER WHEAT TO MEXICO UNDER EEP FOR AUGUST SHIPMENT.
