el. Pour in enough water to soak the sand.

Give it lots of sunlight.

SALAD IN A DISHPAN:

Fill a dishpan or similar container with potting soil. (Be sure container has a couple drainage holes.)

Plant any variety of salad seeds, such as lettuce, spinach, radish, peas, mustard greens, garlic, chives, etc.

When grown make a salad! Kids love to eat what they have grown.

APPLES, PEACHES OR PLUMS:

Put seeds on a moist cotton ball

put in a jar and cover with another moist cotton ball pad. Put jar into refrigerator.

Keep it moist. In about 3 months or so, you will see sprouts.


When seeds are ready to plant, put them in a large container and cover with 2-3 inches of water.

PINEAPPLE:

Cut off top of pineapple leaving about an inch of fruit. Let it sit out for a couple of days.

Using sand and a container with drainage holes, place pineapple top in sand. Cover with sand up to the green leaves.

Water often. Check for roots in a couple of months. Plant in potting soil.




