PERSEID METEOR SHOWER

his could be an especially good year for viewing the Perseid meteor shower, which peaks between August 11 and 13 during the waning Moon. The Perseids may be seen approaching from the Northeast, appearing to come from the constellation Perseus. In fact, the flying particles were spawned by Comet 1862 III, and are debris from the comet that has spread out along it's orbit. The best time to see the

show may be after midnight on August 12 when 40 to 60 meteors per hour (or perhaps several hundred per hour) may be seen. But if you really want to catch a falling star be sure to check during each night of the peak

When the Moon is not full, the stars shine more briahtlu.




