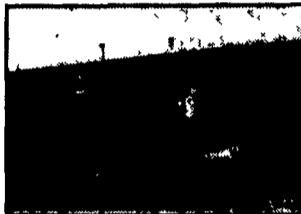

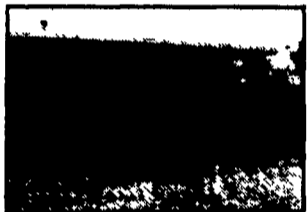

SAN DIEGO, Calif. — The U.S. Feed Grains Council named a new slate of officers for 1993-94 at its 33rd annual board of directors meeting.

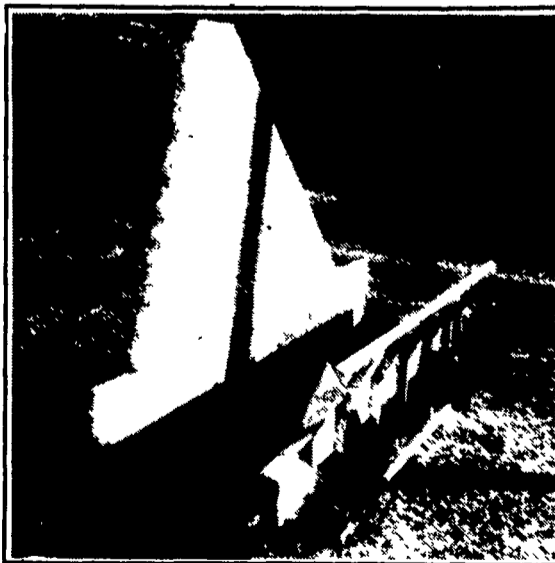
