One milking animal was shown, a junior 3-year old shown by Joy Hess, which received honors as best animal bred and owned and senior champion for the breed.

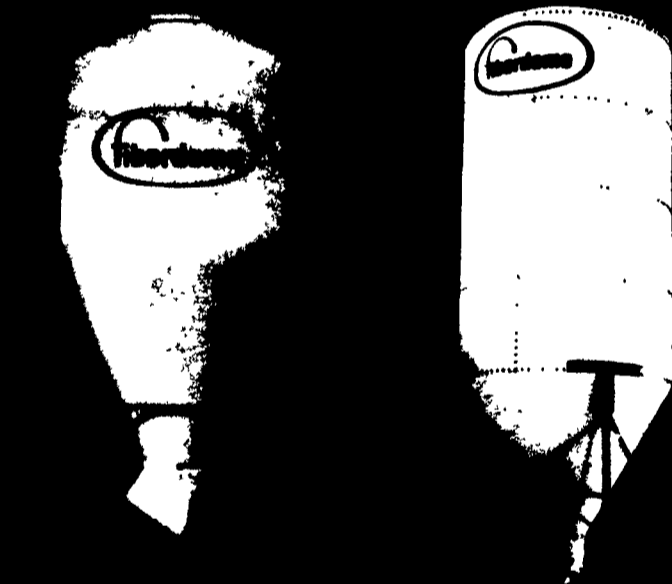
