

Ag Progress Schedules Ice Cream Churn-Off

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The fifth annual Ice Cream Churn-Off at Ag Progress Days will be held on Wednesday, August 18, beginning at 1 p.m., at the dairy promotion booth, located

at the corner of Main and West Eighth Streets. The contest features seven competitors making their own homemade ice cream recipes.

Recipes for the contest include

“Grapenut,” “Orange Sicle Cream,” “Very Berry,” and “Peanut Butter Fudge Chip” ice creams.

All recipes are original and will be made at the dairy promotion

tent for a panel of judges. Three recipes will receive prizes: first, \$300; second, \$150; and third, \$100.

Judging will be based upon taste and visual appeal, effective use of dairy products, recipe originality and creativity, and ease of preparation. Recipe brochures will be available for Ag Progress Days’ visitors to take home and try. Some ice cream samples will be available for the public, depending upon actual recipe quantities.

This event is just one activity sponsored by Pennsylvania’s Dairy Promotion Partners at Ag Progress Days. The Partners will also have a booth complete with promotion information, a register-to-win contest, and an antique dairy equipment display. An ice cream booth will also be located

on the lot with sundaes and ice cream cones for sale. All proceeds will benefit the Camp Victory Fund. This Fund is used to provide year-round camping activities for children suffering from cancer and other serious illnesses.

Pennsylvania’s Dairy Promotion Partners include the American Dairy Association and Dairy Council, Mid-East UDIA/F.O. 36 Advertising Agency and the Pennsylvania Dairy Promotion Program.
