### Vaccinate To Protect Animals

NEWARK, Del. — Whether you own a pet or raise animals commercially, proper vaccinations can help ensure your dog, cat, horse, cattle, sheep, swine or goats lead a healthier, more productive life.

"Not vaccinating is like playing Russian roulette," said Dr. Rich

Barczewski, University of Delaware Cooperative Extension livestock specialist. "You never know when a problem will arise. Vaccines are relatively cheap compared to treatment regimes for diseases. And once the disease is contracted, treatment may not be effective.'

humans, and is spread when one animal bites another. Rabies is of major concern right now because of the increased number of cases in the area.

"It's always a good idea to vaccinaté your dogs and cats. And if you live in an area of rabies outbreak, vaccinate livestock as well," Barczewski said.
