

All-American Deadlines Set

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Preparations are under way, final details are being worked out, and entries for the 30th Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show are arriving at the Farm Show Office.

The first entry deadline was August 20. Entries postmarked on or before August 20 were accepted at \$15 per animal.

Entries on August 21 through Sept. 1 will be accepted at \$25 per animal. Entries must be submitted on the forms provided by the All-American.

• The college has the highest budget for research within the entire Penn State University system. "We're committed to doing research that matters," he said, adding that the world-wide influence of the college is growing.

• The college depends upon private funds for support. Last year, in competing for external research

• He said the college is one of the leading institutions in interdisciplinary and intercollegiate cooperation, even though he said it was strained by limited resources. "In 1984, the initial computer network was started. Currently, Hood said

the computer hardware system is out of date and needs updated. He noted that Penn Pages, the college's computer information access system, recently celebrated its 1 millionth access for information. It has been in operation since 1985.

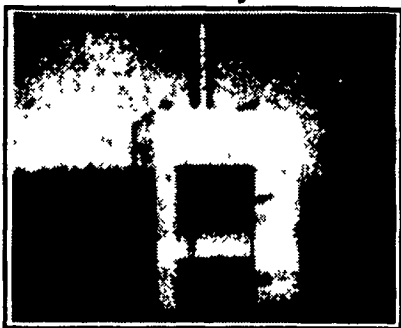
A statewide satellite system to be used in conjunction with the computer system is the next stage, he said. Ag Sat is to provide a dedicated up link at the college and 67 terminal downlinks (satellite dishes) across the state. There are 30 installed at this time, he said. Once in place, it will allow for "very wide information access."

• Since the university went to be a member of the Big 10 colleges for sports reasons, the effect has been good for the college of agriculture, because now it is allowed to be involved with international project consortia and the college is currently involved in projects from Albania to Poland.

• Enrollments at the college increased 6.3 percent last year, and an increase is anticipated for this fall, though it was too early for fall enrollments to be estimated, he said. In the past five years, including last year, he said enrollments have increased 29 percent.

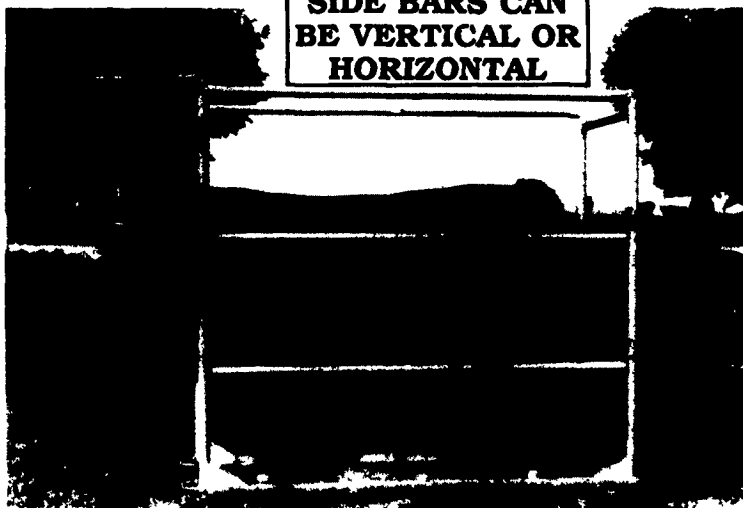
