Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers \$1.00-\$3.00 lower. Calves and light yearlings unevenly steady. Demand moderate for yearlings; moderate to good for calves. Quality of yearling supply plain to average, small end attractive; no improvement in quality over last week. Large supply of first, second, and third grade Brahma cross. Weigh condition average to full and considerably less attractive to buyers than last week. Flesh condition of yearlings slightly thin to moderately fleshy. Calf flesh mostly average. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 lower with exception of breaking Utility \$1.50 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Dry weather thruout much of the state has prompted increased movement of cows the past few weeks. Receipts this week 12,350; last week 12,459; last year 11,906. Supply consisted of 79 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs.; 14 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 7 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.


