Beef And Sheep Winners At Kutztown

KUTZTOWN (Berks Co.) — Stephanie Bowman of Lenhartsville, PA and Bruce Snyder of Kutztown had a tremendous week at the Kutztown Fair. Snyder and Bowman finished first in the Showmanship and Fitting Contest respectively. Judge Marilyn Stroh of Lafayette Hill, New Jersey, was kept busy, there were eight different breeds exhibited in the breeding stock show plus market lambs in this strictly youth Sheep show.

Champion Ram and Champion Ewe in the Corriedale Breed was shown by Kelly Glaser of Limekiln. Dominating the Dorset classes was Bruce Snyder of Kutztown. Snyder took home all the Champion and Reserve Champion honors for the Dorsets. There were 37 Hampshires exhibited and Theresa Anspach of Shillington had Champion Ram and she also exhibited the Champion Ewe. Hailing from Robesonia, Jason Manwiller showed the Champion Oxford Ewe as well as the Reserve Champion Ewe.

The Rambouillet breed winners were divided between Grand Lazarus of Germansville who swept the Ram classes and Kystal Anspach of Schillington who won the Champion and Reserve Champion Ewe ribbons. In the Shropshire classes Tom Newpher of Fleetwood won both the Champion Ram and Ewe titles, while Victoria Reiser of Mohnton, won Reserve Champion Ram and Megan Perry of Hamburg won Reserve Champion Ewe.

Southdowns were well represented and Lee Gauker of Fleetwood won Champion Ram and Bruce Snyder won both Champion and Reserve Champion Ewe titles. The last breed shown were the Targhees. Samantha Gressley of Fogelsville won all the Champion rosettes for this breed.

The Showmanship and Fitting contest and the Blocking and Grooming Contest judge was Tim Fleener of Robesonia. Snyder and Bowman, both veteran showmen,

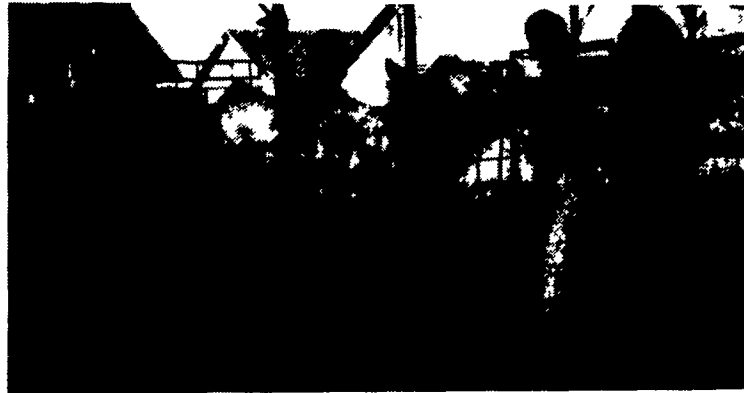
demonstrated their skills and were victorious in winning the Champion and Reserve Champion fitting and showmanship awards respectively.

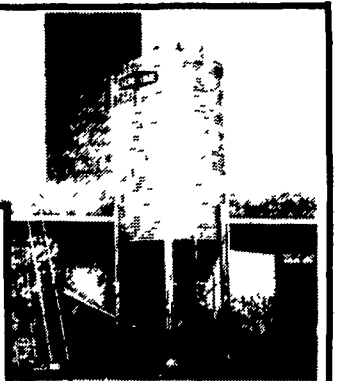
