

# Armstrong County Holds Junior Livestock Sale

**KITTANNING** (Armstrong Co.) — At the recent Armstrong County Junior Livestock Show and Sale, grand champion market steer, exhibited by Tiffani Huff, was purchased by Hoss's Steak & Seafood House for \$2.85 per pound.

The reserve grand champion market steer was exhibited by Jonathan Stockdale, purchased by Stockdale Meats for \$2.25 per pound. Champion carcass steer belonged to Curt Stockdale, purchased by Brocious Lumber for \$1.60 per pound. Reserve champion carcass, exhibited by John Hergert, was purchased by P & N Coal Co. for \$1.60 per pound.

County-bred champion steer belonged to Mike Gahagan, purchased by W & G Livestock/J.C. McCoy for \$2.10 per pound. Reserve champion county bred steer belonged to Curt Stockdale, purchased by B & B Oil & Gas. A total of 19 steers were sold, with an average of \$1,052 per head, excluding champions.

There were 41 market lambs sold, beginning with the grand champion market lamb, belonging to Dawn Gahagan, purchased by Dr. Jack Drummond/Bill Wolfgang for \$11.50 per pound. Reserve grand champion market lamb, exhibited by Matt Johnson, was purchased by National Bank of the Commonwealth for \$2.05 per pound. Grand champion carcass lamb, shown by Blaine Nichols was purchased by Kittanning Foodland for \$3 per pound.

County-bred champion market lamb belonged to Tim Johnson, purchased by David Rumbaugh for \$1.60 per pound. Reserve champion county bred, exhibited by Melissa Johnson, was purchas-

ed by W.G. Satterlee & Sons for \$1.60 per pound. A total of 36 additional market lambs were sold at an average of \$257 per head, excluding champions.

The sale concluded with the sale of the market hogs. Champion market hog was exhibited by Chad Stiteler, purchased by Dr. Jim Stiffler for \$5.20 per pound. Reserve champion market hog belonged to Tyler Good, purchased by Stockdale Transport for \$2.50 per pound. Grand champion car-

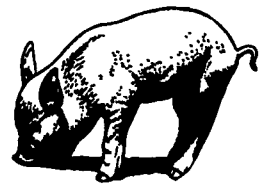

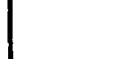
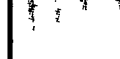
