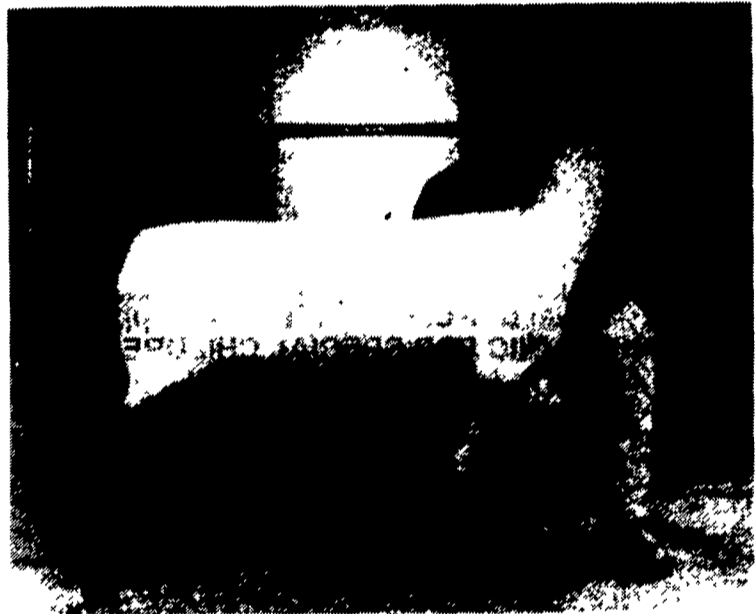
new industry in the state. The \$20 non-member fee includes a coffee break and a bison meat luncheon. Reservations are requested at (412) 658-4082.
