Oley Fair

The Oley Valley Community Fair will be held on Thursday, September 16 through Saturday, Sept. 18 on the fire company grounds in Oley located at Routes 73 and 662.

The Oley Valley Alumni Band will perform at 1:30 p.m. and the Happy Dutchmen Strolling Band will wander the grounds from 1 to 4 p.m. Trophies will be awarded to department winners at 6 p.m. The majority of the trophies have been donated by The National Bank of Boyertown.

All entertainment of the fair is sponsored in part by The National Bank of Boyertown, Patriot Savings Bank, and Meridian Bank. Entertainment will be held rain or shine under the Volunteer Pavilion. While some seating is available, fairgoers are invited to bring lawn chairs. Admission is free. Donations for parking are accepted. 




