New Weigh Of Life

My New Weigh of Life takes an informative, active, individual approach to weight loss and maintenance.

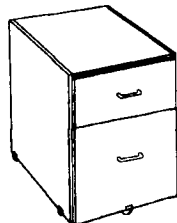

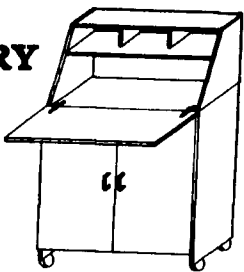

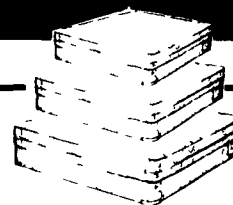
