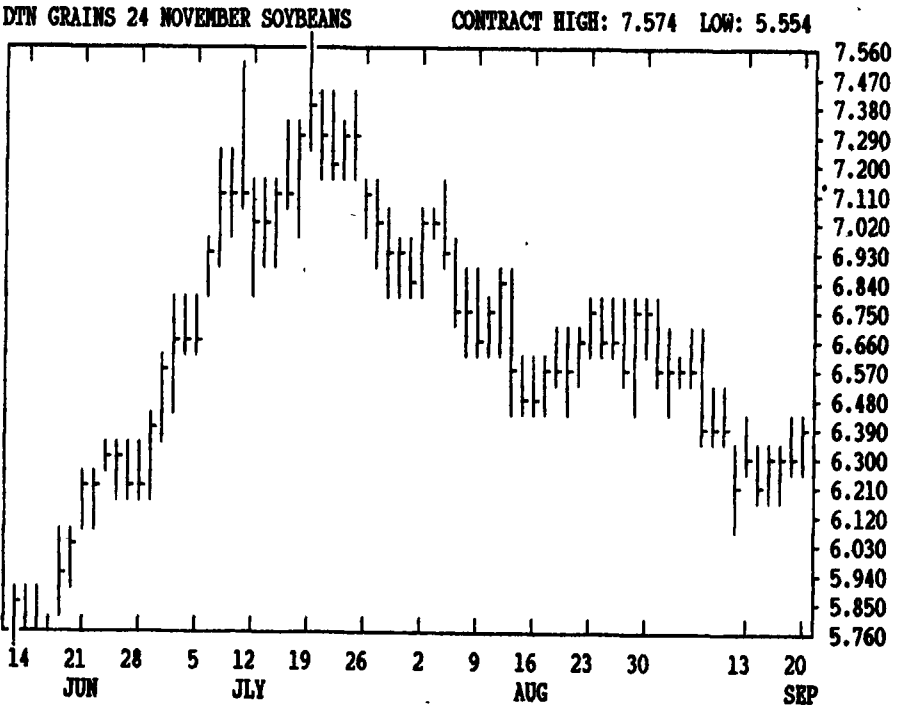
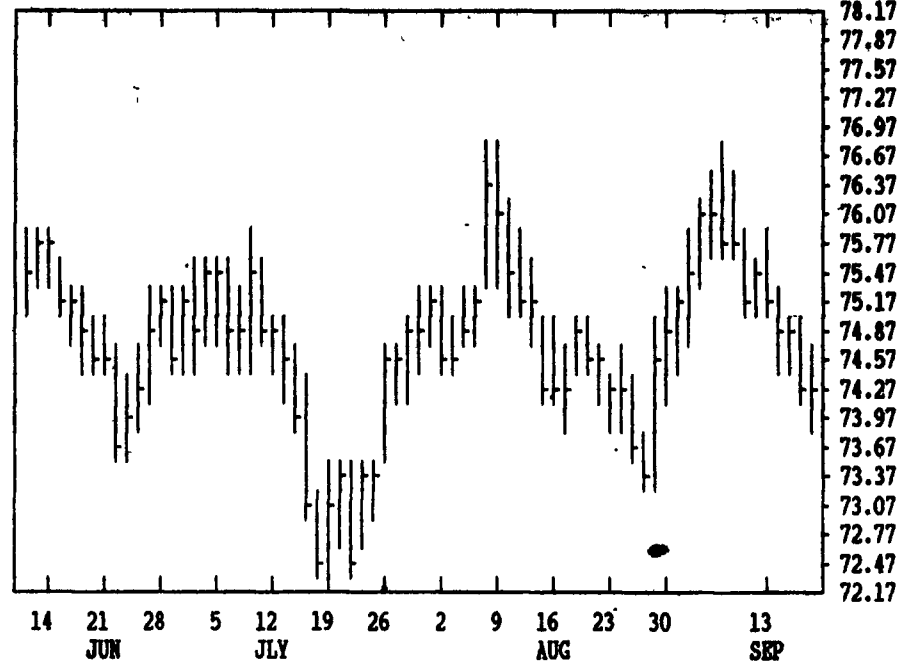

4-Year-Old Cow Becomes Ephrata Fair Supreme

EPHRATA (Lancaster Co.) — A 4-year-old Holstein, Turnpike-View Furious Dam (S: Dale-Pride Val Furious, D: Turnpike-View Columbus Daphne) won supreme champion cow on Wednesday afternoon at the Ephrata Fair.

The animal, owned by Dennis Gerhart, 21, was exhibited by his brother, Mark, 18, Reinholds. The cow exhibited "good dairy character throughout, with a definite advantage in the mammary system," according to Rick Hess, nutrition consultant with Hess Mills, Paradise, judge for the show.

Mark said he was happy to show the Cloister FFA project animal for his brother, Dennis, who had to work. Parents of the brothers are Charles and Mary Gerhart, Reinholds.

For the two other breeds present, Tom Zartman, Jr. swept the championship of the Brown Swiss show. Ayrshire show champion went to John Gerhart.

DENVER (Lancaster Co.) — Casey High, 14-year-old son of Larry and Mae High, Lititz, exhibited his 1,218-pound steer named "Boxer" to supreme champion beef of the Denver Fair last week. Reserve champion was shown by Ben Weist, 10.

Casey's 1,218-pound steer sold to Badorf Shoe Company, Lititz; for \$1.65 per pound at an auction following the show. Ben's 1,248-pound reserve was sold for \$1.10 per pound to Keystone Farm Credit.

At the show, Tammy Gelsinger exhibited the grand champion Farm Show preview steer. Her brother Troy exhibited the reserve champion.

Tammy placed first in the senior showmanship class, followed by Troy and then Casey. In junior showmanship, Ben Weist placed first and Kyle Zerbe was second. Kyle had the top lightweight preview steer. Of the sale steers, Casey had the top lightweight, followed by Tammy and Richard Kerper and Jason Manviller. Ben Weist had the top heavyweight sale steer, followed by Troy Gelsinger and Peter Hoffines.

Show judge was Ken Winbark, Lebanon County agent. Auctioneer was Henry Leid.

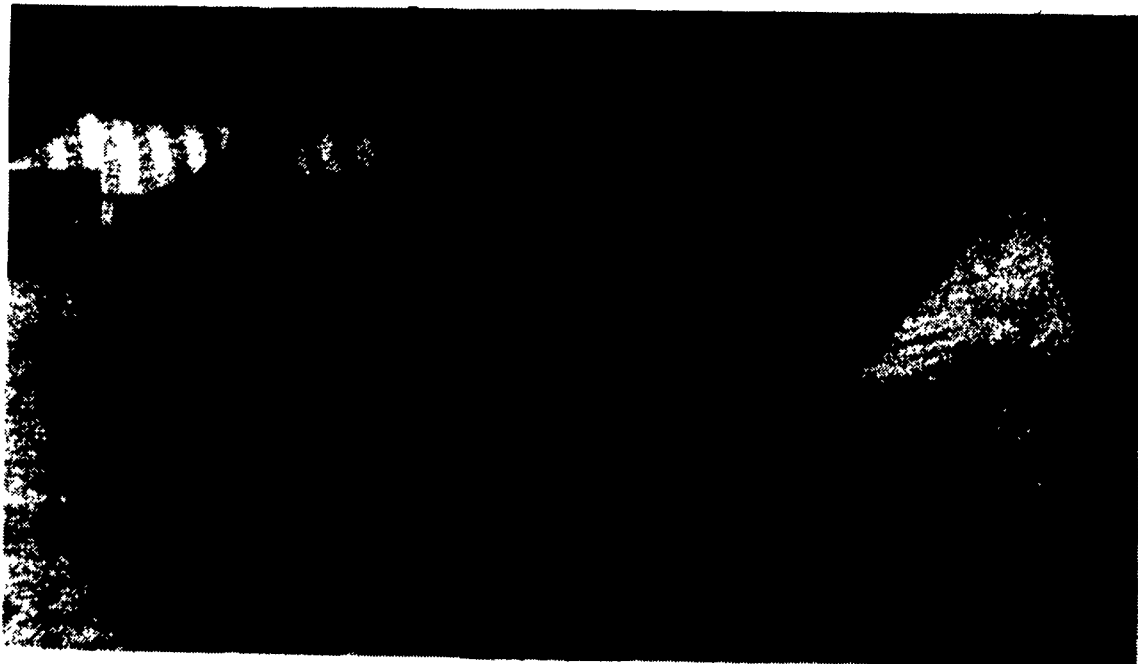
