entries to the 47th Pennsylvania
Central District 4-H Dairy Show

at the Mifflin County Youth Park in Reedsville, they found two new events topping the show - the selection of a supreme champion and a supreme best bred and owned.

Juniata, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Snyder, and Union counties showed their Ayrshires, Guernsey's, Milking Shorthorn, Brown Swiss, Jersey and Holsteins hoping for not only top honors, but blue ribbons that would qualify then for the state 4-H Show at the Farm Show Complex on Sept. 20.

Type judge Dale Olver of State College called the show one of the strongest district shows and chose 110 blue ribbon animals. Fitting judge Brian Fleisher of Newport awarded 40 fitting awards and Dale Fiedt of Millersburg awarded 44 showmanship awards.

During the final few minutes of the show, judge Olver surveyed the grand champions from the five breeds and then awarded supreme senior champion to Rachel Tanis' Holstein senior 2-year-old, C Sunnylodge Para. Tanis, from Centre County, won fitting and showmanship awards for this Dairy-Lane Tri Paramount - ET daughter who also won senior and grand champion honors.

Reserve supreme champion went to the reserve senior and

reserve grand champion Holstein, a 4-year-old owned by Dianne S. Glock of Juniata County. Walnut-Hills Astro Binky, a Bridon Astro Jet - ET daughter, was then selected as the supreme best bred and owned animal. Judge Olver complimented the planning committee on the foresight in adding the supreme classes.

Lauren D. Daubert's Brown Swiss winter calf was selected as the supreme junior animal. Victory Acres Chal Teela, an R Hart CJ Challenge ET daughter, was






