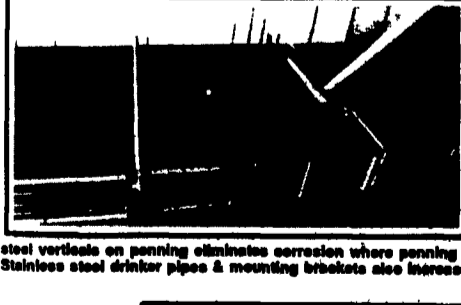
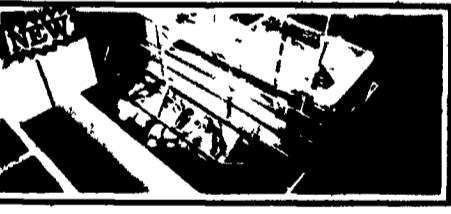


3000 Head "Double Wide"
