Tied for 1st Place in the 1992 New Jersey NCGA Yield Contest (Class A Non-Irrigated) for Rustin Farms of Trenton with 219.84 bpa.  
 Management tips: Widely adapted. Excellent top end yield potential under irrigated and favorable conditions. Relatively small seed size. Very good resistance to Southern Corn Leaf Blight. Average 1st and good 2nd generation resistance to corn borer.
