

Called "Molly Pitchers" thanks to their tireless efforts fetching water for the men, many also helped by swabbing cannons after each firing. The best known of these women was Mary Hays. Born on October 13, 1754, near Trenton, New Jersey, Mary's hero-ism came at the Battle of Monmouth on June 28, 1778. While Mary was loading and firing a cannon after her husband, John, was wounded, an enemy cannonball passed between her ankles, tearing away the fringe of her petticoat.

Use borax and vinegar in a 4:1 ratio to clean and deodorize the toilet. A half-and-half mixture of borax and baking soda makes a great scouring powder.
