

Clinton Concludes Fair With Livestock Sale

LOCKHAVEN (Clinton Co.) — The 21st Clinton County Fair concludes each year with the 4-H Livestock Sale. There are three firsts for this year. The animals were sold by the "head" instead of by the pound.

Also listed were actual market prices for the bidders benefit. The buyback packers were H.J. Bierly Livestock of Mill Hall and Walter M. Dunlap & Sons of Lancaster.

Also new this year are market goats. This project gives younger members an easy animal to handle. Goat meat has similar nutrient value to beef but somewhat leaner.

The 23 goats weighing between 50-78 pounds sold between price range of \$400-\$60. The average was \$114.13.

The grand champion goat owned by Luke Snook of Loganton sold for \$400 and was purchased by Central Pa. Auto Auction of Mill Hall. The reserve champion owned by Angie Beck of Mill Hall sold for \$200 and was purchased by William Ingram Fuels, Inc. of Mill Hall.

Lock Haven.

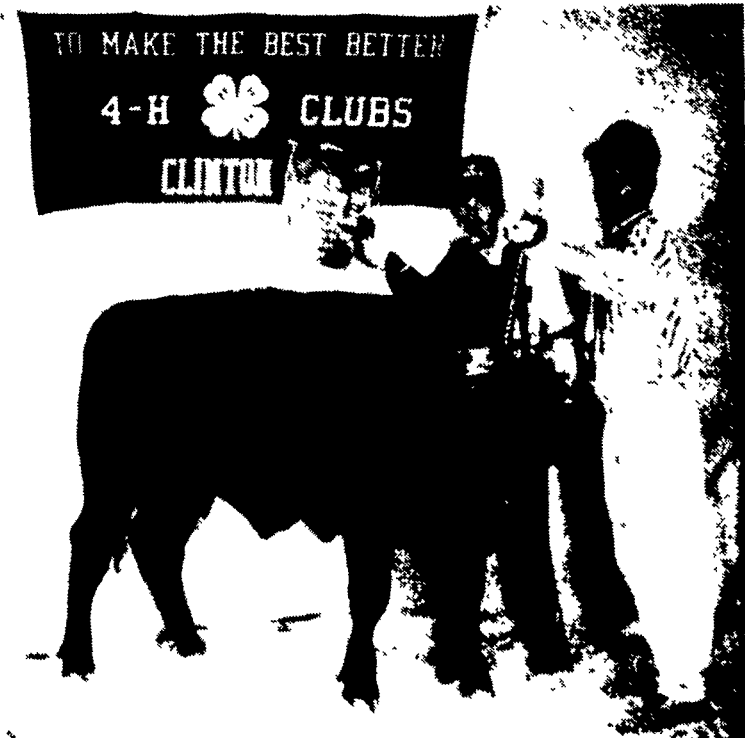
