Farm Fields

Cover-Crop

CHALFONT (Bucks Co.) — Now is the time to decide if you will need to cover-crop after you take off corn silage or harvest soybeans.

Cover-cropping provides residue to meet the requirements of your conservation plan for percent residue cover for next spring.

Cover crops should be planted to allow at least four inches of growth or 50-percent ground cover by winter. The purpose of cover cropping is to control erosion dur-

ing periods when the major crops do not furnish adequate cover, add organic material to the soil and improve infiltration, aeration, and tilth.

If you are planning on using a grain drill to seed your cover crop, two bushels of winter grain per acre should be used. Many people believe that cover cropping is too time-consuming when time is valuable during harvest season.

Several farmers in Bucks County have found that to use time more efficiently, they broadcast three to four bushels of winter grain per acre on previously

harvested fields in the morning, while waiting for the soybeans to dry off, before starting to combine soybeans or chop silage later in the day. This seems to work well with their harvesting operation.

It is important to increase the amount of seed used to cover-crop when broadcast spreading is used because of a poorer germination rate and poor seed-to-soil contact.

Remember, check your conservation plan or call the USDA, Soil Conservation Service, to see if residue management is part of your farm conservation plan to be implemented by the end of 1994.

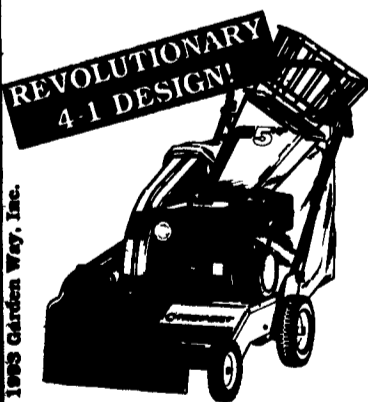

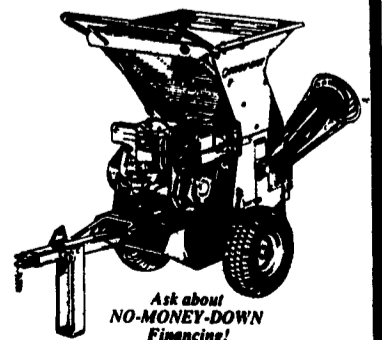
