

PSU To Sponsor Dairy Teleconferences, Workshops

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — Penn State's Department of Dairy and Animal Science, in collaboration with the College of Agricultural Sciences, is to sponsor three Dairy Nutrition Teleconferences and Workshops on February 10, 17 and 24, 1994. These workshops are to be of-

fered via satellite at more than 45 locations in Pennsylvania and several nearby states.

The dairy nutrition teleconferences and workshops combine local hands-on activities conducted by extension agents and interaction with University faculty via satellite. Research, teaching, and

extension faculty will have a chance to share their collective expertise with dairy producers and feed industry representatives across Pennsylvania and in several nearby states.

Producers can ask questions about their own farm operations to expand their knowledge of nutrition and feeding management. Participants are encouraged to bring one forage sample to the first workshop to be analyzed for use in the second workshop.

Each workshop will start at 10 a.m. and end at 3 p.m. with one hour for lunch. Each workshop will feature several video segments presented via satellite, exercises, and discussions on nutrition-related topics conducted by county agents, and a question and answer period with several specialists in dairy nutrition, agronomy, and agricultural engineering.

Participants will be limited to the seating capacity at each site. Early registration is requested by December 6, 1993, but those who do not register early will be

permitted to register late if space permits.

The \$25 registration fee covers costs for the forage sample analysis and other items used during the workshops. An additional charge

will be made if meals are provided, but this will vary with site. To register or to obtain more information, contact the Penn State Cooperative Extension office in your county.

S. 340 has been assigned to the Senate Labor and Human Resources Committee while H.R. 1423 has been assigned to the House Energy and Commerce

Committee.

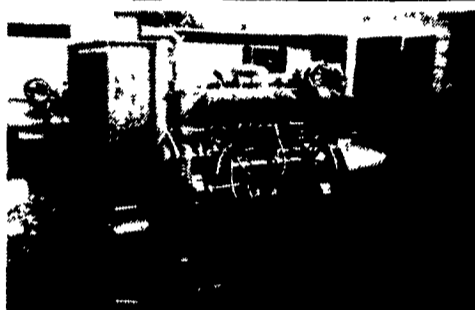
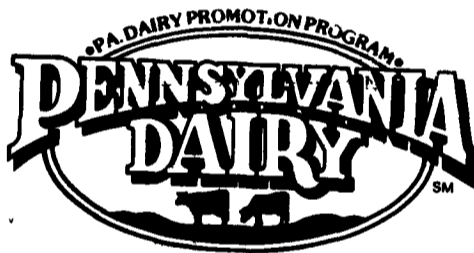

While some new tillage equipment is to be demonstrated, much of the program is to focus on using common equipment already owned and used by farmers.

Also, the demonstrations are designed to be practical and insightful. "After each type of primary and secondary tillage is demonstrated, residue measurements will be made and recorded for comparison. The effect of deep tillage on residue will also be demonstrated. Farmers attending will learn how to measure the percent of residue cover," according to the brochure.

There is also to be free testing of grain moisture testers. A representative from the state Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Weights and Measures is set to be there to perform the free-for-participants, tester-accuracy checks.

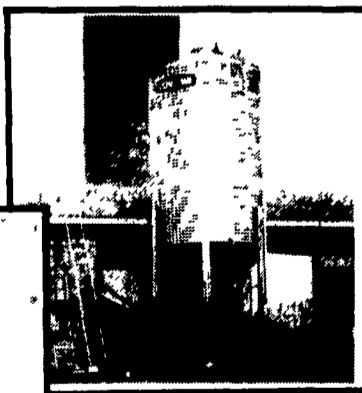
