**Bradford To Hold Groundwater Meeting**

TOWANDA (Bradford Co.) — Since we cannot see groundwater, it is one of our most misunderstood natural resources. However, because 87 percent of Bradford County residents depend solely upon groundwater as their sole source of drinking water, it is vital that the general public become familiar with the basics of groundwater.

The public will have an opportunity to become more familiar with the topic of groundwater on Tuesday, November 16 at 7:30 p.m. at the Sheshequin-Ulster Elementary School in Ulster, Pa.

The topics will include groundwater basics, groundwater contamination, and how to properly drill a well.

One of the featured speakers will be Bryan Swistock, Penn State water quality project associate, who will address which contaminants Bradford County residents should be most concerned about.

This public meeting will be presented by the Bradford County Water Quality Task Force.
