**DHIA Rate Increase**

Beginning November 1st, PA DHIA will be passing on some fee increases directly to Chester County DHIA members. The services provided by PA DHIA lost money during the 1992-93 test year and had to withdraw money from their reserves to cover costs and to purchase on-farm computers. In order to put the Association back on a firm financial footing, the following increases were approved by the State Board on a per cow/per test basis:

Processing samples	1.0 cent
SCC	1.0 cent
Basic service	2.5 cents
Replenish reserve	2.0 cents
Research	1.0 cent
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>7.5 cents</b>

This increase will show up on all herds tested on or after November 1, 1993.

**Dairy Farming in Suburbia**

One of the issues that concerns dairy farmers in Chester County is whether their operations can continue to co-exist with increased residential housing developments. Farmers are asking questions such as: Do my neighbors understand that cows make manure daily and

that it has to be disposed of on the fields? Do they realize that farm machinery can only go 20 miles per hour on the road? Do suburbanites comprehend that a farmers' fields are the source of his income and not a public park for the community?

These are the type of issues that cause confrontations between farmers and their non-farm neighbors. Dairy farming can continue to prosper in developed areas, but both sides need to understand each other's concerns. Granted, it is more difficult if you are the last farm in the township, but even in this case there have been success stories.

The key to a successful farm/city relationship is for both sides to get to know each other. Farmers that take the attitude that they were here first and neighbors have to accept whatever they do are just as bad as the new homeowner who has moved to the country, but doesn't want to tolerate any normal farming activities. At one time, most people in this country had a relative that farmed. Today that is not true, and all too often they think food just appears out of nowhere on the supermarket shelves.
