Doebler's 73XP - R.M. 112

Super healthy outfielder with 173 bu. at Weyers Cave, VA in '93. 149 test sites in '91-93 and averaged 155.8 bu. @ 24.7% H₂O. Highest yield was 229.9 bu. 1992 PA Five Acre Corn Club Champ with 214.1 bu. - excellent test weight.

Doebler's 75X2 - R.M. 116

Doebler's Home Run King is 75X2. Averages Wow - VA Corn Growers '91 and '92 tests this was tops. 200 bu. in '92. Rutgers Exten. in '92 hitting 207 bu. Penn State Comm. Mat. Zone 4 it was 175.4 bu. - Univ. of Del. Hybrid Perf. Summary at Smyrna - 216.1

Doebler's 69XP - R.M. 106

Big hitter in '93 had 218 bu. in Augusta Co., VA (irr.) and 172.5 bu. at Dorchester Co., MD 186.9 bu. in Lancaster Co., PA (both non-irr.) Averaged 153.3 bu. over 259 areas from 1990-91-92.

Doebler's 66XP - R.M. 103


Doebler's 35XP - R.M. 84
