**Doebler's 27XP Relative Maturity - 80** Short season only, but this hybrid has good grain quality and good yielding capability. New in '92, tested at 74 sites this variety averaged 136.4 bu. Having some yields in the 170 bu. bracket.

**Doebler's 35XP Relative Maturity - 84** A tough little hybrid hitting a high yield of 175.5 bu. @ 27%. Around since 1988, this vigorous early grower has produced many yields averaging 154 plus bushels.

**Doebler's 45XP Relative Maturity - 92** 92 N.Y. Hybrid Corn Perform. Trials Med. Early Summ. 45XP did 154 bu. Better than 10% of our locations tested had averaged 166.4 bu. Number of sites 236. It had a high yield of 204.5 bu.

**Doebler's 57XPA Relative Maturity - 96** This hybrid can play a number of positions on your farm. Used as an early corn in a late area or as a 96 day mid-season. High yield was 192.3 bu. and at 55 test sites in 1992 thirteen percent averaged 174 bu. @ 22.2% moisture.

**Doebler's 62XP Relative Maturity - 102** New in '92 harvest season this player has shown real potential. Averaged 145.4 @ 93 locations. Better than 13% on those sites averaged 191.1 bu. The 1993 season has seen 185.3 bu. in Berks Co. and 177.5 in Lancaster Co., PA.

**Doebler's 66XP Relative Maturity - 103** This variety is the Superstar. Put it in your lineup. 192.2 bu. at Kutztown and 160 bu. at Shade Gap, PA in '93. Check the average 1987-92 at 723 sites hit 143.0 bu. Highest yield 225.5 bu. @ 25.8% H<sub>2</sub>O. Top sixty-five areas averaged 185.4 bu. @ 22.4%.

**Doebler's 69XP Relative Maturity - 106** Big hitter in '93 had 218 bu. in Augusta Co., VA (irr.) and 172.5 bu. at Dorchester Co., MD. 186.9 bu. in Lancaster Co., PA (both non-irr.). Averaged 153.3 bu. over 259 areas from 1990-91-92.

**Doebler's 73XP Relative Maturity - 112** Super healthy outfielder with 173 bu. at Weyers Cave, VA in '93. 149 test sites in '91-93 and averaged 155.8 bu. @ 24.7% H<sub>2</sub>O. Highest yield was 229.9 bu. 1992 PA Five Acre Corn Club Champ with 214.1 bu. — excellent test weight.

**Doebler's 75X Relative Maturity - 113** Fantastic, solid, tremendous — words that could describe this hybrid. Consider this, 819 tested areas since 1986 to '92 and this corn averaged better than 140 bu. @ 24% H<sub>2</sub>O. Can you think of all the different types of weather and soil exposure it experienced. Highest official yield 281.6 bu. in PA Five Acre Corn Club.

**Doebler's 75X Mod. II Relative Maturity - 114** If the maturity fits, you may want to take the big wagon to haul in the tonnage this hybrid will produce. Proven, 1st place with 27.3 tons per acre in the 1992 Penn State Late Med. Season Silage Test. Highest recorded corn yield 191.7 bu. @ 23.5% H<sub>2</sub>O. Site tested 66 times from 1991-93 and averaged better than 150 bu. @ 25.9% H<sub>2</sub>O.

**Doebler's 75X2 Relative Maturity - 116** Doebler's Home Run King is 75X2. Averages Wow — VA Corn Growers '91 and '92 tests this was tops, 200 bu. in '92. Rutgers Ext. in '92 hitting 207 bu. Penn State Comm. Mat. Zone 4 was 175.4 bu., Univ. of Del. Hybrid Perf. Summary at Smyrna - 216.1.

**Doebler's 82XP Relative Maturity - 116** Big News 82XP placed 2nd in silage tests at '92 Penn State Late Med. Season with 26.2 tons. Rutgers Coop. Ext. topped 26 tons. No one better. Definitely big league, the records prove it. A 1993 harvest in Lancaster Co., PA hit 204 bu. and 193 bu. in Berks Co., PA.

**Doebler's 86XA2 Relative Maturity - 122** A real game maker that can handle big yields. '92 VA Coop. Ext. at Blacksburg hit 191 bu. Univ. MD Perform. Trials at Wicomico Co. hit 190.3 bu. 1992 Rutgers Coop. Ext. yielded 197 bu. with 86XA2. CONSISTENCY.

All hybrid yields are based on 15.5% moisture.
