

PHEAA To Continue Loan Forgiveness

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.)
— For the second year, the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA) will implement the Agriculture Education Loan Forgiveness Program, according to state Rep. Jeffrey Coy.

The program, created in 1992 by the General Assembly, helps graduates in agriculture-related fields and veterinary medicine repay their student loans. They must return to work on a family farm or practice veterinary medicine that includes agriculture animals.

"This program offers up to \$2,000 per year to pay PHEAA-guaranteed student loans for every year the individual is employed on the family farm or practices as a vet," Coy said.

Coy said the program set a maximum of \$10,000 in loan forgiveness payments.

Additional criteria that must be met in order for an individual to be eligible for the program includes graduation from a Pennsylvania college or university; certification by the U.S. Department of Agriculture to sign health certificates

required for interstate commerce of ag animals and animal products; the authorization to certify regulatory testing; employment on a family farm that is being used for the production of commercial agricultural products, and these farms must devote 75 percent or more of their assets to the business of agriculture.

respect for Hal Doran, for what he stands for, and his impact on cooperatives world-wide. Roth emphasized the need to constantly look ahead, to always consider how cooperatives can meet the needs of members in a changing world - the speeding up of technology, increasing worldwide involvement, and the movement of production agriculture away from family farms and a way of life to family business. Roth said the concept of cooperative operations are being challenged and that co-ops need to constantly look at how they can address member needs in order to serve. He ended with a reminder that cooperatives are always made up of the membership.

The 1993 annual meeting of the Pennsylvania Council of Cooperatives was held November 2-3 at the Nittany Lion Inn in State College and was this organizations tribute to "60 years of service to the cooperative community".

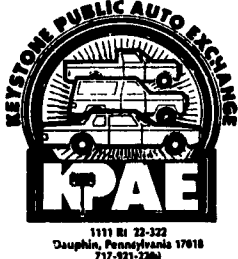
