ST. THOMAS (Franklin Co.) — When it comes to cooking with honey, the tables have certainly turned. Once relegated to desserts and tea time, honey has moved from the back of the cupboard to the forefront of the food world. And things have never tasted better. That's the message Pennsylvania Honey Queen Stephanie Lynn Yoder and Pennsylvania Honey Princess Jennifer Sue Henry tell the crowds at fairs, malls, markets, parades and civic organizations where they promote honey. Queen Stephanie has been

watching her grandfather, Jacob Sollenberger raised honey bees ever since she was born. Her grandfather started raising honeybees during World War II when sugar was scarce. After the war, sugar was plentiful but by then, the family was hooked on the sweet taste of honey. Her grandfather is still a beekeeper and has hives on Stephanie's parents' dairy farm. Nineteen-year-old Stephanie is the daughter of Samuel and Barbara Yoder of St. Thomas. She has a younger brother, Daniel, and the

family has cared for many foster children over the years.

Music is a strong interest for Stephanie. She is a freshman at Messiah College majoring in music education. She plays the piano and saxophone. Before graduation from James Buchanan High School, Stephanie was active in music programs, student government, and track. She is active at West Side Brethren In Christ Church with youth and a full-time pianist since the eighth grade.

In addition to being the state honey queen, Stephanie is on her second term as Franklin County Honey Queen. She will compete for the title of American Honey Queen in Orlando, Florida in January.

Honey Princess Jennifer Sue Henry is the 20-year-old daughter of Marvin and Mary Henry of McVeytown, Mifflin County. She has a younger brother, Justin.

Jennifer can trace back her family's commercial beekeeping for three generations. Often visiting Pap and Grandm (Merle and Emily Fisher) at the farm, she got a look at what it takes to be a beekeeper. Her dad also has a few hives.

Jennifer graduated from Lewis-town Area High School and is a junior at Juniata College majoring in elementary education.

She has always been active in sports, especially basketball, and plays for the Juniata College basketball team. For the past two summers, Jennifer counseled camps for the Keystone State Basketball Camp Program. Her activities include 4-H, cross country, and downhill skiing.

As an active member of McVeytown United Methodist Church, Jennifer has held offices in it and in the United Methodist Youth Fellowship.
