DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN SUMMARY IMPROVED EXPORT INTERESTS AND TIGHT SUPPLY OF MILLING QUALITY WHEAT EX-TENDED GAINS IN WHEAT PRICES: CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES CLIMBED SHARPLY HIGHER ON TIGHT FARMER HOLDINGS AND GOOD DOMESTIC FEED DEMAND. WHEAT 1 TO 9 CENTS HIGHER, CORN 4 TO 7 CENTS HIGHER. SORGHUM 1 TO 8 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS 8 TO 10 CENTS HIGHER. MODERATE GAINS WERE MADE IN WHEAT PRICES DUE TO ACTIVE EXPORT DEMAND AND LACK OF AVAILA-BILITY OF MILLING QUALITY WHEAT. SPILLOVER STRENGTH FROM CORN AND BEAN PITS ALSO SUPPORTED WHEAT PRICES. CORN AND BEANS REMAIN IN TIGHT HANDS AS PRICES CONTINUE TO ADVANCE. EXPORT DEMAND SLOW BUT NEW INTERESTS SHOWING UP ON BOOKS. IDEAS USDA MAY CUT FURTHER INTO CROP PRODUCTION FORECAST ADDED STRENGTH TO PRICES. TRADERS AWAIT THE DECI-SION ON N.A.F.T.A.
