

Kenburn Holsteins Receives Award

DeFOREST, Wis. — Kenburn Holsteins, owned by Ken and Bernice Zurin, of Mt. Joy, recently received the Genetic Management System Elite Herd award from American Breeders Service (ABS).

This award is one of 12 that will be given in conjunction with the 25th Anniversary of ABS' Genetic Management System (GMS). Kenburn Holsteins, evolved

from one calf that Ken's uncle gave to him when he was nine years old. That calf sparked Ken's enthusiasm in the dairy industry and today Kenburn Holsteins is home to 285 milking Holsteins producing an average of 23,300 pounds of milk, 797 pounds of fat, and 709 pounds of protein on three times a day milking.

Good management as well as solid genetics are keys to the suc-

cess of the Zurin herd. Artificial Insemination (A.I.) and ABS' Genetic Management System help the Zurin operation achieve production goals set for their 100 percent ABS-sired herd.

The cows are kept in free stall housing and are fed a total mixed ration (TMR). A nutritionist assists the Zurins in balancing their cows' rations.

In addition to the 650-acre dairy

operation, 130 dairy steers are raised on the facilities. Owner Ken Zurin is assisted by wife Bernice, sons Scott and Mike, daughter Nichole, father Sam, brother Keith (herdsman), Keith's wife, Marge, and Keith and Marge's children, Jennifer and Jessica.

GMS has been a part of the Zurin management program for 20 years.

"When our ABS Representative and GMS Evaluator, Jim Charles, started mating our herd I told him to breed the herd like they were his and I'll pay the bill," Ken said.

"In the 20 years we have been working with Jim I've never questioned him, and I've been pleased with the results."

Since then, production has increased yearly and each new calf crop shows improvement in feet, legs, and udder conformation, according to ABS.

Stand-outs in the Zurin herd include five cows from GMS matings, each with a projected 305-day mature-equivalent record of over 27,300 pounds milk. Leading the group is a HILTON daughter who will hit the 30,559 mark.

cows, the Zurins recognize the advantages of GMS evaluation for heifers. Approximately one year ago the heifers were added to the GMS mating program. Through GMS, each heifer's type traits and pedigree are taken into consideration for sire recommendation.

A portion of the herd is also mated to young sires as part of the ABS Progeny Test program.

"I feel that I am getting a jump ahead genetically of those who wait to use only proven sires on their herds," Ken said.

With the help of GMS, the Zurins said they find it easier and less time consuming to select the genetics for building a profitable dairy herd, according to ABS.

The Genetic Management System was designed by American Breeders Service (ABS) to help dairy producers make sound mating decisions for their heifers and cows. The program has experienced tremendous success that can be seen in thousands of herds throughout North America and Europe, according to ABS.
