and \$50 for 25 years service.

Production awards, based on milk production, were presented according to dairy cattle breed.

In the Ayrshire breed, Warren Burkholder, of Ephrata, received top honors for his herd which averaged 17,244 pounds of milk, and 562 pounds of protein.

In the Brown Swiss breed, Donald Trimble, of Peach Bottom, received top honors for average milk production of 16,751 pounds of milk, with 580 pounds of protein.

In the Guernsey breed, Axel Linde and Millie Widmann, of Oxford, received recognition for their herd average of 16,452 pounds of milk, and 574 pounds of protein.

In the Holstein breed, Steve Hershey, of Elizabethtown, received recognition for his herd average of 24,962 pounds of milk, and 772 pounds of protein.

In the Jersey breed, Karl Herr, of Quarryville, received recognition for his herd's average production of 15,516 pounds of milk, and 581 pounds of protein.

The top protein production herd award went to Bob and Karen Gochenaour, of Willow Street. Their herd averaged 24,870 pounds of milk, and 783 pounds of protein.

The low somatic cell count award went to Curtis Akers, of Quarryville, whose herd averaged 107,000 SCC.
