NATIONAL EGG MARKET - AT A GLANCE: Prices were unchanged to higher for the large sizes in the Northeast, and the balance of prices were unchanged. The market tone was steady to firm. Demand continued to be seasonally good to excellent. Supplies were tight to instances adequate, and extra eggs were held with confidence, or offered at premium prices. Breaking stock supplies were adequate from regular commitments, and reduced schedules were planned this week. Live hen offerings were at least adequate for the light to moderate demand, and the trade sentiment was generally steady.
