loan guarantees, and grants ministration (RDA) will bring greater economic opportunity to rural Pennsylvania. "Farmers and rural communities have been especially hard hit

by our stagnant economy," Sen. -Wofford said. "For the last 12 years, our government has not had an aggressive program to help rural communities by creating jobs, providing loans, improving infrastructure, and offering incentives for doctors to relocate in rural areas. "This money is a step in the right direction toward giving rural families the resources they need to live in safe homes and communities and succeed in today's economy.'

The \$284 million is a significant increase over previous funding levels, especially for water and waste facilities and loan guarantees for single-family loans, according to Cheryl Cook, director of the Pennsylvania FmHA.

"We are very exicted at the opportunity to provide rural Pennsylvania with a tremendous shot in the arm," Cook said. "I have directed my staff to do as much public outreach as possible to ensure that all eligible Pennsylvanians have an opportunity to be served."

FmHA's 37 county offices offer loans throughout Pennsylvania for farm ownership and operation and single-family housing. These field offices also handle housing repair grants for older citizens.
