ATTENTION DODGE CITY ** OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Compared to last week: Feeder steers and steer calves steady to \$1.00 higher, most advance on 800-900 lbs.. Feeder heifers and heifer calves steady to \$2.00 higher. Trade active on light pre-holiday supplies. Demand excellent for both calves and yearlings. Quality average and attractive. Flesh mostly in buyers favor, slightly thin to average. Weight-ups mostly average to gaunt. Slaughter cows fully \$2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls firm to \$1.00 higher. Demand from packers continue good as supplies shorten. Total of 451 cows and bulls sold. Receipts this week 3,213; last week 7,580; last year 2,629. Supply consisted of 63 percent yearlings and few calves over 600 lbs.; 22 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 15 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
