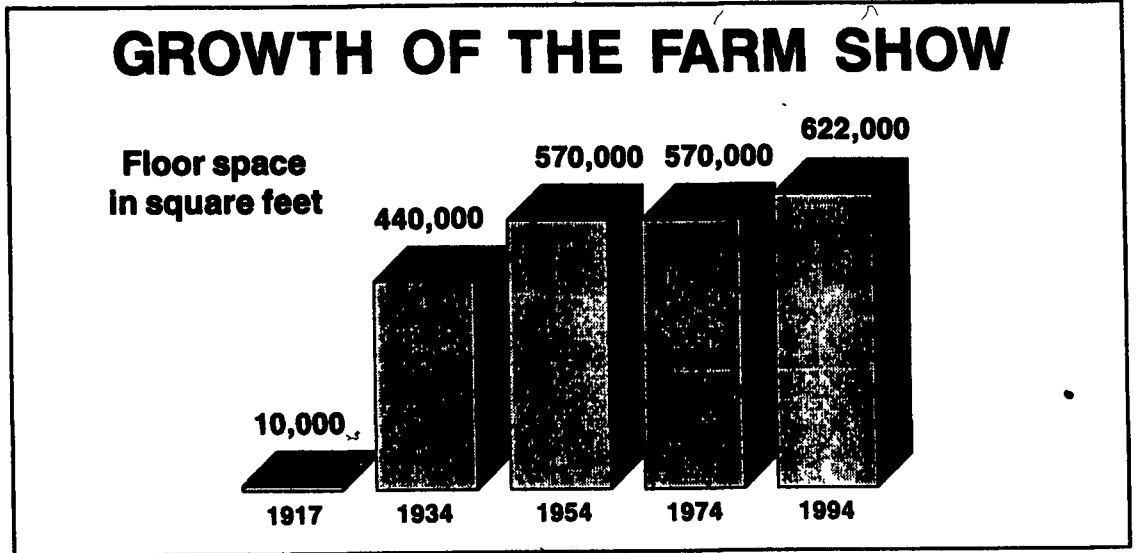

- * Admission is FREE for all events during Farm Show Week.
- * The Farm Show Complex is located along Cameron and Maclay Streets in Harrisburg, just off Exit 23 of Interstate 81. To alleviate major traffic congestion on I-81, PennDOT marked Harrisburg highways with alternate routes to the Farm Show Complex. Route 39, Route 22/322, Route 230 and Elmerton Avenue can also be used.
- * Parking is available on the 60-acre site for \$2 per vehicle. Overflow parking is offered at the Harrisburg Area

Community College (HACC) with shuttle bus service to the Main Exhibit Building for a fee.

- * Handicapped parking and access areas have been expanded and can now be found along the South Entrance, the North Entrance and in front of the Large Arena.
- * Security during Farm Show Week is provided by the Pennsylvania State Police, Farm Show Security and contracted security services.
- * Lost children and parents should report to the State Police Command Center along the north wall of the Main Building.
- * Restrooms are located throughout the Farm Show Complex.
- * Diaper changing tables are located in the mens and womens restrooms in the Main Building and in the corridor that joins the Main Building with the North Building and the Large Arena. Nursing mothers can find a quiet spot in the EMS room by the Large Arena.
- * Coat Checks are located in the South Lobby and Large

Arena. The fee is 50 cents per item.

- * Information booths are located throughout the Complex.
- * Lost & Found items are kept in the Farm Show Security Office, located in the corridor between the Main and North Buildings.
- * Food is available throughout the Complex. The famous commodity food booths are located in the East Building, snack bars are located around the facility, and a cafeteria on the second floor of the Main Building offers complete meals and a la carte items.
- * The Emergency Medical Services Room with doctors, nurses and ambulance attendants is located on the Lower Concourse of the Large Arena.
- * Public pay telephones are available throughout the Farm Show Complex.
- * The Director's Office and Press Room are located on the second floor over the Main Lobby. The Radio Room is off the Lower Concourse of the Large Arena.

Last year the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation marked Harrisburg highways with alternate routes to the Farm Show Complex in an effort to alleviate major traffic congestion.

Message boards and Keystone signs will help Farm Show visitors along these recommended routes into the Farm Show and HACC parking lots.

- Traffic heading north on I-81 toward Harrisburg will be directed to get off at Exit 22 onto Front Street. Turn right onto Linglestown Road, right onto Industrial Road and follow that into the parking lots.
- Commuters travelling east on Route 22/322 will take the Rockville Exit, go south on Front Street, turn left on Linglestown Road and right onto Industrial Road. This leads to the parking lots.
- Traffic heading south on I-81 toward Harrisburg will take Exit 24, turn right onto Progress Avenue, turn right onto Elmerton Avenue and continue straight a few miles to the parking lots.

A rash of fatal accidents in construction zones around Harrisburg this year has officials doing everything in their power to make the roadways safer for motorists and workers alike. Most of the projects should be completed or suspended for the winter, except for an area on I-81 near Carlisle and a project on Routes 11-15 just above Harrisburg.

Motorists should also be advised that turning lanes have been reconstructed around the Farm Show Complex.
