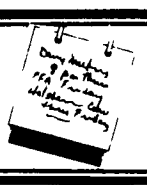

NURSERY PENNING

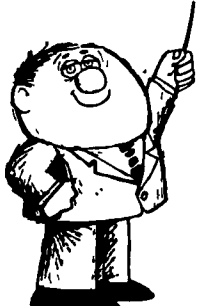
