**Jersey Milk Climbs**

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio — For the first time in history, the average milk production for Jerseys has leaped to more than 15,000 pounds nationally.

With the increased emphasis on protein in the past few years, Jersey producers are also excelling in keeping up in the marketplace by increasing protein production at a greater rate than fat production.

In 1993, the Jersey breed averaged 15,231 pounds milk, 706 pounds fat, and 564 pounds protein on a mature equivalent basis.

This average is based on a total of 49,318 lactations computed for milk and fat, and 49,251 lactations computed for protein.

The 1993 average production shows a 2.4 percent increase in milk production, a 2 percent increase in protein production, and a 1.6 percent increase in fat production compared to 1992 figures.

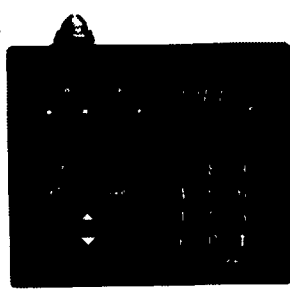
