Wayne County Dairy Day Set

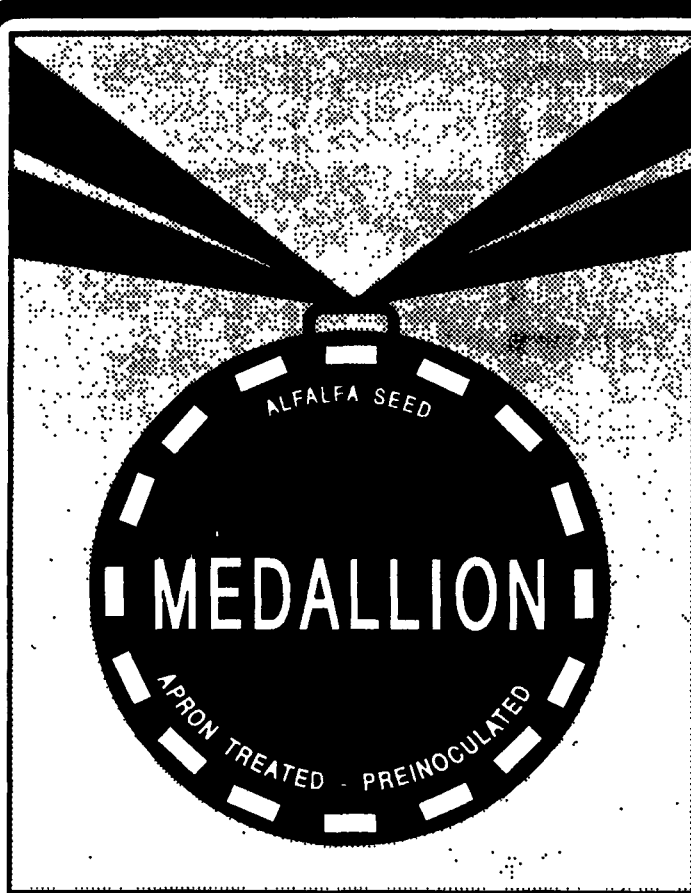
