ST. JOSEPH, Mo. — A total of \$8,000 in college scholarships will be awarded to five young men and five young women involved

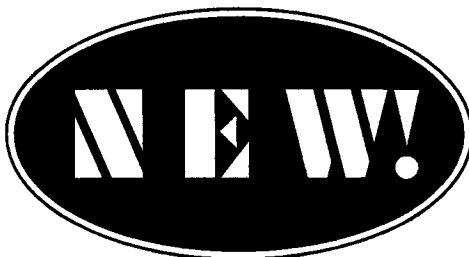
in the Angus business.
