The afternoon program featured discussion on BST. Jacob Guggey, Bradford County agent, and

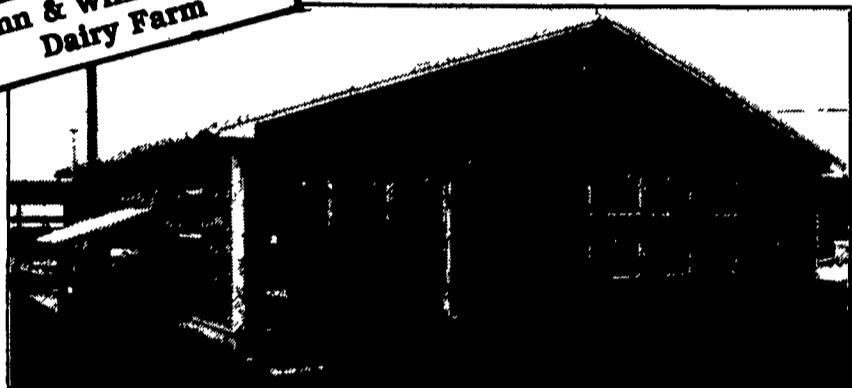
Jeff Harding, Monsanto, Inc., spoke about BST issues and answers. As expected, there was considerable interest in this subject and many discussions among the listeners.

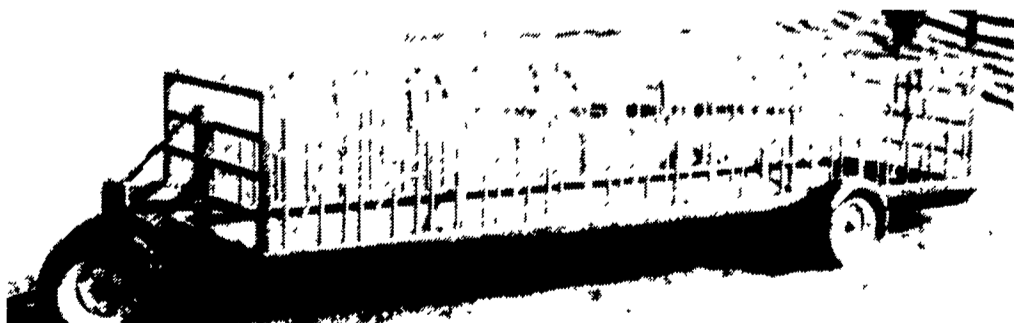

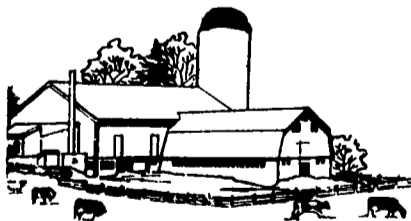
