

Md. To Host National Soil Judging Contest

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — Maryland will host the 34th National Collegiate Soil Judging Contest, scheduled April 15 on the Eastern Shore. There will be 16 universities competing. All are top teams in their respective regional contests around the nation.

The precontest banquet will be held on April 13 in the Kent Narrows area on the Eastern Shore. Dr. Richard W. Arnold, chief of soil surveys for the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Soil Conservation Service (SCS), will be the guest speaker at the banquet. The awards presentation will take place the afternoon of the contest.

Contest coordinators are Dr. Martin Rabenhorst, and Dr. Delvin Fanning, professors of soil science at the University of Maryland at College Park. Other helpers include the UMCP Agronomy Club and Soil and Water Conservation Society student chapter; Diane Shields, a SCS soil scientist in Queen Anne's County; and Jim Brewer, area SCS soil scientist at Easton.

The 16 schools that will be competing are as follows: Texas Tech University, University of Tennessee, Ohio State University, University of California — Davis,

Virginia Tech, Cornell University, California Polytechnic State University - San Louis Obispo, Utah State University, University of Wisconsin - Platteville, Southwest Missouri State University, University of Kentucky, University of Idaho, University of Arkansas, Iowa State University, Pennsylvania State University and Purdue University.

In the Northeastern Collegiate Soil Judging Contest last fall, the University of Maryland A team placed third among six schools. The competition was held Oct. 23 at Pennsylvania State University's Rockspring Research Farm. The Penn State team captured first place with 3,537 points, Cornell was second with 3,407 points, and Maryland was a close third with 3,405 points.

Individuals in the top 10 from Maryland were Sam Buonocore, from Pomona, N.Y., who placed third and Susanna Watson, from Bethesda, who took ninth place.

The Maryland team has won two national titles in the past 34 years. However, because Maryland is the host state, the University of Maryland team will not be competing for national honors this year.

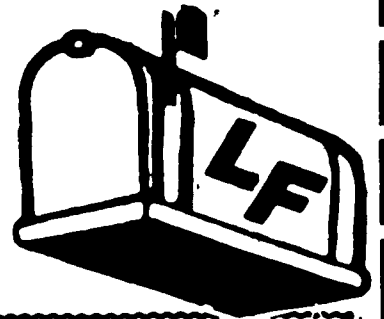
