Using Swine Waste In Grazing Programs By incorporating intensive grazing technology with a better agronomic use of animal waste, pork producers in North Carolina are becoming cattlemen with

stocker grazing programs. Working with extension agents in Sampson County, pork producers are irrigating pasture land with swine lagoon effluent and studying the performance of grazing beef calves. The results have been promising, with producers reporting return per acre in the \$400-\$420 range.

Benefits of low labor, less hay making, and a release from weather concerns are also positive aspects of this alternative to utilizing swine waste.

The North Carolina programs have mostly utilized coastal bermudagrass as the main forage, with fescue incorporated in some programs. Stocking rates on bermudagrass in the intensive rotational grazing system have reached 7-10 cavés per acre. Programs

irrigating pearl millets, rye grass, watermelons, cucumbers, and bell peppers have also been research-

Can we do this in Pennsylvania? There certainly is an opportunity to explore this technology. perhaps utilizing fescues, orchardgrass, brassicas and maybe even vegetables! Land values will remain a factor in the development of programs related to utilizing swine waste to graze cattle.
