Fine Arts — oils, watercolors, drawings and prints including a York Square trolley car scene "Lirban Crossroade", a large oil on canvas by Roger M. Rittase; (2) oils of Spring Grove Glatfelter works "Smoke Patterns" and Schwartz's Barn" by Hokie; oil of Herper's Ferry "Massey's Corner"; watercolors: New Oxford, Frantz House, Waynesboro and others; original pen and ink of "Irlah Fiddler" by Henry Morgan, 1855.

Collection of Lady Prints — N. Currier, Currier and Ives, Sarony and Major, Harrison Fisher, Rare "Independent Gold Hunter" by Kellogg & Comstock. Other prints by Lou Meyer, Delcroix, Moeler, Prang, etc.

Shenandosh Pottery — redware and atoneware including John Bell mottled cuspidor and flowerpot; blue-decorated pieces, crocks, pitcher, canning jers and jug. This group contains a rare decorated John Bell 1-1/2 gallon crock. Also Cowden and Wilcox decorated pieces and F.H. Cowden.

Rugs — hooked and braided, French handhooked wall hangings (Fount-a-lie)


Baskets — splint, willow and wicker baskets.




