

L.T. before 10 days of age. Recommended times for broilers is 10-12 days after birth but no later than four weeks. Roosters and capons should be vaccinated twice at two weeks and eight weeks. Breeders and layers should be vaccinated twice at seven and 15 weeks.

Flocks can be vaccinated after an outbreak if the majority is not showing clinical signs of the disease. It is unknown if vaccines can also be a source of outbreaks, but newly vaccinated birds do shed virus for one week after vaccination and should not be exposed to nonvaccinated birds.

For those who question how insurance companies establish premiums for farms, Gregory Kirkham of Old Guard Mutual Insurance Company explained the many aspects influencing the premiums.

Castastrophe losses from winter storms in this area actually exceeded losses from those reported from the Los Angeles riots, the California earthquake, and the Homestead hurricane, Kirkham said.

Farmers can reduce premiums by reducing their chance of loss by making sure of adequate electrical wiring protection from rodent problems. Insulation must be covered with acceptable ignition barriers. Fire extinguishers, lightning rods, and reduced combustible materials near buildings reduce the risk of fire. Biosecurity measures and equipment safety are positive influences in reducing premiums.

Enrollment in a quality assurance program guarantees an immediate rate reduction, Kirkham said.

Farmers can sign up for Pennsylvania's egg quality assurance program until June 30, said John Hoffman of the Pennsylvania Poultry Federation.

Enrollment in the program is voluntary, but once you enroll you sign a contract to uphold standards. If you become dissatisfied with the program, you can resign, Hoffman said.

The program assures buyers that the products are safe from salmonella. If a flock in the program tests positive, the eggs must be diverted to the breaker until the flock tests negative for four consecutive weeks.

The cost of tests, sampling material, and technical assistance is the responsibility of USDA and the Poultry Association and not the farmer, Hoffman said.
