Dairy Benefit Sale Raises \$31,000 For 4-H Center

QUARRYVILLE (Lancaster Co.) — Construction of the Romano 4-H Center in Chester County came closer to reality after more than \$31,200 was raised here in the fairgrounds at the 4-H Center Dairy Benefit Sale last Saturday.

About 37 head of cattle (all young stock), in addition to dairy supplies of all kinds, went on the auction block at 11 a.m. in front of a total of 49 bidders. Other donated materials included 13 embryos, 55

units of semen from proven bulls, and 30 units of young sire semen.

The highest-selling calf was Rocky-Side Starbuck Sandra, born 6-16-92 and bred 7-1 to 9-7-93 to Conrid Holiday Bab Esau, donated by Jefferson Yoder, Elverson, in memory of Carl Yoder and sold for \$2,350 to Stanley Guest, Pottstown.

The second-highest selling calf was LS-Reid Greenwood CNB Sandy, born 7-26-92 and bred 9-10-93 to Tesk, donated by Land-

Average price for the animals was \$616. Average for the embryos was \$243. Average for the semen was \$22.39.

Cash donations at the sale

totalled \$2,850 for a total income of \$31,232. Estimated expenses, including cost of fairgrounds, advertising, food for workers, etc. amounted to \$2,200, for a net profit for the Center of \$29,032.




