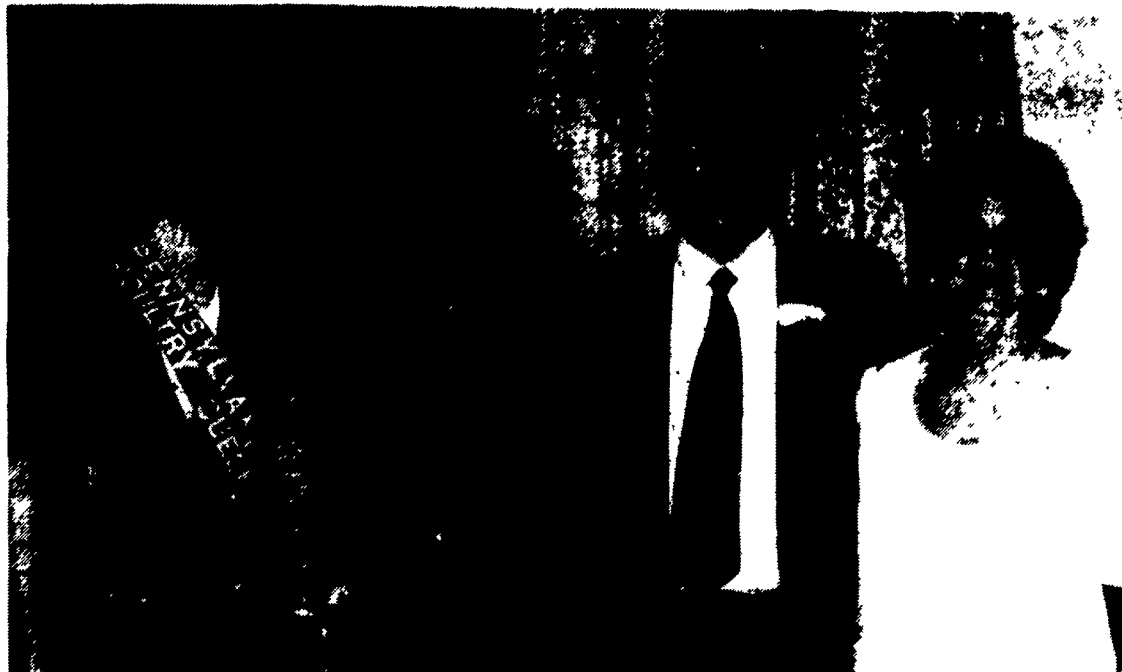

Herd Catchup Program Offers Discounts

BRATTLEBORO, Vt. — The Holstein Association Board has created an opportunity for breeders who have gotten behind on registry work to catch-up their herd at discounted fees. The catch-up program is expected to result in added animals for the national genetic pool, making more Hol-

steins eligible for classification, pedigrees and other performance records.

The new program provides special prices for herd owners who register at least one overage female plus all eligible female animals under 24 months of age in the herd.

Registry applications for this program will be accumulated and sent to the Brattleboro home office by Holstein Association field representatives or classifiers.

Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility criteria require that a breeder must be state and national member of Holstein associations; have a minimum registry of one overage female animal; and register all eligible female animals under 24 months in the herd.

Reduced fees are effective until Dec. 31, 1994; Registry applications will be sent to Brattleboro by national association staff. Payment plans may be arranged on a special case-by-case basis.

Fees

Fees are set so the females over 23 months are \$50; animals 12-23 months are \$20; and animals under 12 months are the normal fee.

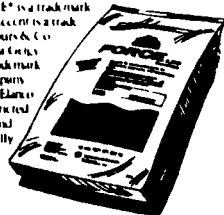

FORCE may be applied in a T-band in front of the press wheels, in a band behind the press wheels, or in-furrow.

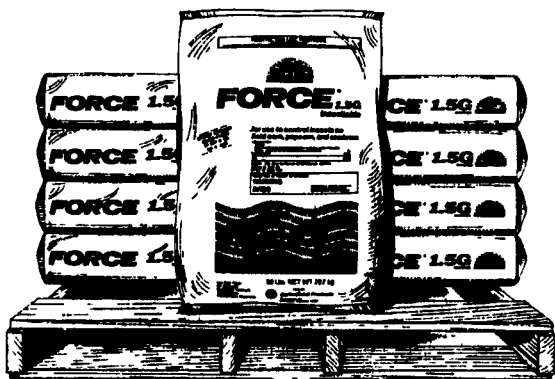
