Heather Dawn Dougherty will

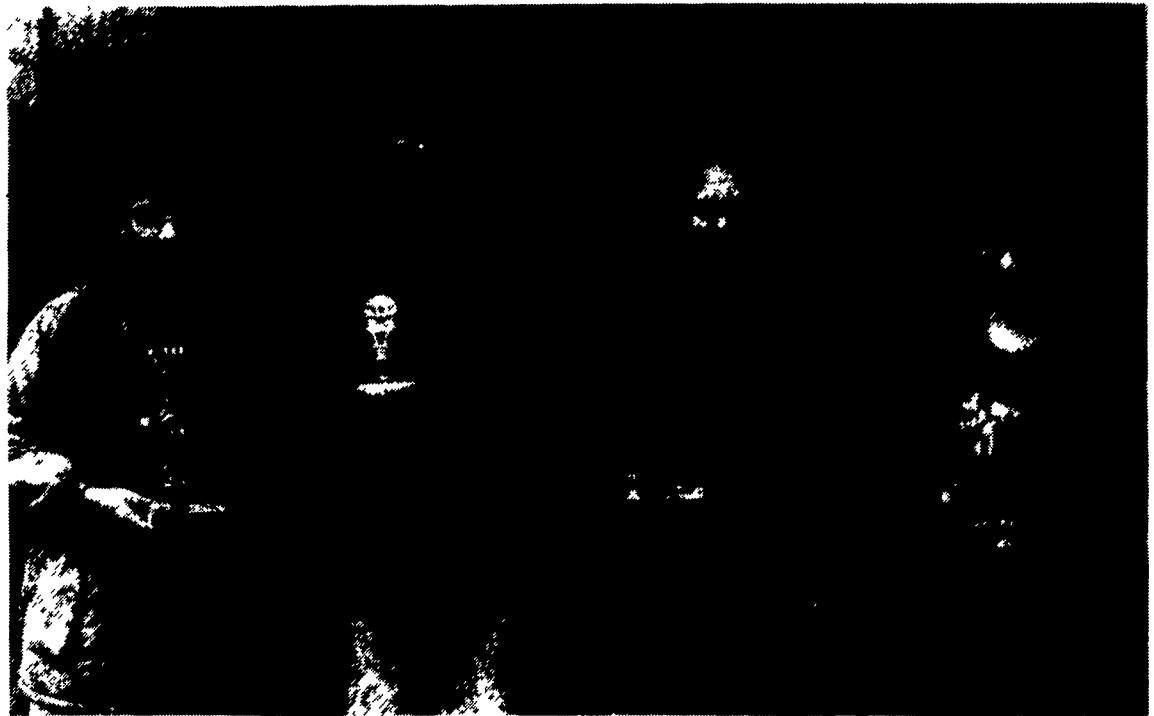

She is the daughter of Debra Dougherty of Elverson.

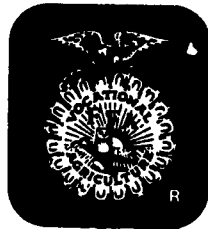
